Hostel Accommodation in Stockholm

When travelling to or from one of our experiences, you may wish to consider adding extra nights in the beautiful city of Stockholm, the "Venice of the North", to your trip.

Nature Travels is pleased to offer you affordable hostel accommodation at a high standard in the green centre of Stockholm, just 8 minutes by underground from Stockholm Central bus and train station. The hostel is located on one many islands on which the city stands, the island of Södermalm, known to most people as simply "Söder".

It is located in a green oasis in the south part of Stockholm city, a quiet and conveniently situated hostel in Södermalm's largest park: Tantolunden. Despite its peaceful surroundings, the hostel is only eight minutes by underground from the Central station, and within easy reach of the small shops, galleries, restaurants, pubs and theatres that contribute to the special atmosphere on Söder.

The Hostel:

You can choose either to reserve a room with shower and WC in the corridor, or a room with shower, WC and TV in the room. Alternatively, you may choose to reserve a bed in a 4-bed room, shared with other like-minded travellers.

Facilities

Self-catering kitchen - internet - laundry facilities - bike rental - sauna - sun beds - restaurant, bar and café.

Bed linen and towel

Bring your own or hire as optional extra.

Breakfast

Either prepare your own breakfast in the guest kitchen, or purchase the large breakfast buffet.

Cleaning

Upon arrival you pay a cleaning deposit. On check out, you can choose either to clean the room yourself and have the deposit refunded, or have the room cleaned by the hostel staff (in which case you would not receive a refund).

Garage

Your car can be parked securely in the indoor garage. Cost around £8/night. To ensure space please reserve in advance.

Check-in and check-out

The rooms are ready for check-in by latest 3 p.m. If you arrive earlier, and your room is not yet ready, you are welcome to store your luggage in the luggage room. Check-out is at 12.00 midday.

The largest room accommodates up to 70 delegates in a theatre-style setting.

Information about the area:

Stockholm

Stockholm is a city like no other - a city built on 14 islands, where you are never far from the water. Well-preserved medieval buildings stand alongside modern architecture. Stockholm is also home of the Nobel Prize, and just outside the city an archipelago of 24,000 islands is waiting to be explored.

Stockholm is a city of contrasts - water and islands, history and innovation, small town and big city, short winter days and long, light summer nights - with a dazzling array of impressions. Thanks to the city's compact size, you can see and do most things in a short space of time.

Experience Stockholm's many contrasts. Discover a city of contrasts. Go back 750 years in time and feel the medieval atmosphere of the Old Town "Gamla Stan" as you wander

through the narrow streets. Stockholm has history, but also the latest in fashion and IT. The fashion-conscious Stockholmers are often used as a test market by international companies as they are quick to pick up on the latest trends. This is most obvious on the island of Södermalm, a hotbed of fashion, youth culture and entertainment.

Stockholm is one third water, one third green belt and one third city. The island of Djurgården, the world's first National City Park, is only a short walk from the pulse of the inner city. Stockholmers and visitors alike come here to relax in the leafy shade.

In Sweden, the seasons are another contrast. Light summer nights when the sun barely dips below the horizon and short, snowy winter days. Because the city changes with every season and there is always something special to do, Stockholm is worth visiting at any time of year.

Södermalm:

In the district of Södermalm, you will find yourself in the very heart of Stockholm, a rare mix of historical tradition and dynamic development. Here, the urban environment offers everything from ancient cobbled lanes to green parks and, in the area round Södra station and Södra Hammarbyhamnen, spectacular modern architecture.

The district is notable not only for its rich cultural life and its many bars and restaurants but also for the strong sense of community among its inhabitants, so it's hardly surprising that Södermalm has become one of the most attractive areas in all of Stockholm. Today 110,000 people live in the district of Södermalm.

Getting there:

NB: We advise you not to buy equipment or clothes for your trip or to incur other non-refundable expenses such as flights until you have received confirmation of your booking from us in writing.

From Stockholm Arlanda airport to Stockholm Central station

You can travel between Stockholm Central train station and Arlanda by trains, including the Arlanda Express high-speed trains, local trains and the SJ railway company's long-distance trains. The train station is directly under the airport building.

Alternatively, you can travel by bus. Both special flight buses and local bus lines stop at Arlanda.

Travel from Stockholm Central train/bus and underground station:

Take the underground, the red line, southward towards Fruängen or Norsborg. Get off at station Zinkensdamm, approximately 8 minutes. Walk along Hornsgatan to no:103 and walk down the stairs. Walk straight ahead between the apartment buildings and you will find the hotel on the left hand side.
