

Wilderness Canoeing in Lapland, Sweden

WILD CAMPING AND PADDLING

Length 5 days

When June - August

Cost £870 per person, land only

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THE FAR north of Lapland, with its endless days of sunshine, is so wild that, once on the water, the only other mammals you'll see are likely to be antlered. Led by local guides, you'll paddle through the timeless landscape of the boreal forest - which circumnavigates the earth, broken only by the northern seas.

This trip's pace is dictated by you, as

once in the Pearl River Nature Reserve you can paddle as much or as little as you like.

You'll wild camp for four nights, choosing from a multitude of shore-side camping spots each day, or even returning to the same one if you don't fancy breaking camp. The area is also great for hiking, so if you fancy a day on land, just choose a hill. You won't have to share the summit view.
